

Lab 2. CSS basics (4 points)

Part 1

1. Create a project folder
2. Put HTML file created in Lab 1 into this folder
3. Create a sub-folder called "css"
4. Create a new .css file inside "css" folder
5. Attach the .css file to your html file
6. Using element selectors, style headings and body text with different fonts of different generic families (serif, sans-serif or monospace)
7. Make sure your fonts degrade gracefully
8. Make at least one of your element groups use a different color
9. Make sure that the color contrasts well with the background

Part 2

10. Make a copy of your html file and a copy of your css file, and attach one to another
11. In the copy use background-color property to color a background of the entire HTML file
12. Change the color of all text in a document (with one selector)
13. Make sure that the foreground and the background contrast properly and do not clash
14. Select at least two in-line elements and make them stand out significantly from the body of the document. Use any property you wish.

Part 3 and 4

15. Repeat step 10 twice, and style two new documents: one with highly contrasting colors (clashing) and another with poor contrast (difficult to read).
